Recipe: Bacon Parm Crackers

INGREDIENTS

1 package bacon strips, cut in half
32 Club Crackers
1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan
Freshly ground black pepper
Ranch dressing, for dipping

DIRECTIONS

FOR OVEN

-Preheat oven to 350° and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper.
-Arrange crackers on baking sheet and sprinkle with Parmesan. Tightly wrap each cracker with bacon and place seam-side down, then top with more Parmesan.
-Bake until bacon is cooked through and bites are crispy, 45 to 48 minutes.
-Season with pepper and serve with ranch for dipping.

What is the RPA?

Edgewater is fortunate to be surrounded by the Swift Creek Reservoir, but we must keep in mind the area from the property lines to the water are owned by the HOA and protected by the Resource Protection Area (RPA). If your home backs up to the water, you must complete the RPA form before touching vegetation for clearing.
